

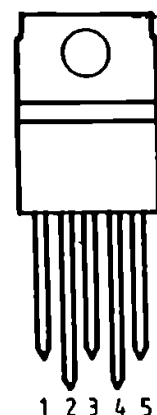
\$ **BTDA 2030**
14 W HI - FI AUDIO POWER AMPLIFIER

The BTDA 2030 is a monolithic integrated circuit in penta-watt package, intended for use as a low frequency class AB amplifier. Typically it provides 14 W output power ($\delta = 0.5\%$) at $\pm 14\text{ V} / 4\text{ ohms}$; at 14 V the guaranteed output power is 12 W on a 4 ohms load and 8 W on a 8 ohms. The BTDA 2030 provides high output current and has very low harmonic and cross-over distortions. Further the device incorporates a short circuit protection system comprising an arrangement for automatically limiting the dissipated power so as to keep the working point of the output transistors within their safe operating area. A conventional thermal shut-down system is also included.
